EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY SUMMER SCHOOL IN SARAJEVO

The **University of Rome La Sapienza**, together with **AESI** and the **University of Sarajevo**, have organized for 2009 a **European University Summer School** in the region of the Balkans, great occasion for getting a deeper knowledge in Cooperation Affairs and International Studies.

The initiative will take place on **22th - 30th of June 2009 in Sarajevo** and is open to participants that are already graduated or that are just about to finish their University program and that, after sending in their CV to AESI, will have passed a general interview. Only 17 people will be admitted. Among the activities planned during the Summer School there will be thematic seminars and workshops, meetings with local authorities, cultural visits in several districts of the country, meetings with the local Universities. Participation to the Summer School is free of charge only for the flight from Italy-Pisa to Sarajevo; accommodation and meals in Sarajevo will be on charge of the participants in a special base of the Italian Ministry of Defense. It is mandatory that every participant must have his own international medical insurance, before leaving for Bosnia-Herzegovina; this will be responsibility and on charge of each participant. In addition, a participation fee will be asked to participants in order to cover organizational costs.

Whoever might be interested is invited to send in by e-mail an application to AESI (segreteria_aesi@yahoo.it), before the **30th of May 2009**. All students that are just about to finish their University program (4 or 5 year courses only) within this year or recent graduates (4 or 5 year courses only) of any faculty, which are also citizens of a EU country, are invited to apply, sending in their CV with a photograph, together with the documentation requested in the application form. Fundamental is that participants have a relevant interest for International Cooperation activities and in particular for the Balkans area, together with a very good knowledge of English language (that will be the main working language during the initiative in Bosnia-Herzegovina).

Selection procedures, that will essentially be a general interview with some easy questions on the three main didactical areas of the Summer School that are Geopolitics and Humanitarian Affairs, Public Health Management and Ethics of International Cooperation, together with general questions about you, your past studies and your interests, will take place the morning of the **8th of June 2009** in Rome, within the University La Sapienza of Rome. For those living out of Italy telephonic interviews could be arranged.
